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

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MEET THE TEAM




Principal Elise L.I.D.T.A

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Our class fees are paid by monthly direct debit. The total cost of the academic year is divided into 12 equal payments, creating a fixed and consistent monthly fee. All payments are processed through our online system, GoCardless.

If your child stops attending classes, simply let us know and we will cancel the direct debit for you.

All payments must be made online using the links provided. We do not accept cash or cheques, and refunds are not offered. In the event that we need to cancel a class, we will make every effort to provide a replacement. A refund will only be issued if a replacement class cannot be arranged.

We are fortunate to have access to a small car park directly outside the studio. Please note though that this carpark is shared by other businesses in the building. It is really important that we use it with care, ensuring that we are not blocking any other cars in or restricting their access.

Children must arrive and be collected on time. Late arrival can not only be disruptive to the class, but also mean that the student misses the warm up, deeming participation in some classes unsafe.

Parents are not permitted to watch classes as this can be unsettling for other, less confident students whilst it is also a safeguarding issue. If you have any worries or questions regarding the content and running of classes, please do not hesitate to contact me.

It is your responsibility to ensure that DDA is aware of all relevant medical conditions and that the student brings any relevant medications to class, e.g. inhalers, epi-pens etc. Please speak to me if you have any concern.

While the upmost care is taken to ensure the safety of students, a certain amount of risk is carried with all physical activity. Students take part in classes at their own risk.

It is expected that teachers, parents and students are all treated with respect. We have a zero tolerance policy regarding inappropriate or threatening behaviour before, during and after class. DDA aims to have a warm, welcoming and friendly environment and so anybody who disrupts this will be asked to leave.
